LIEAP – (Low Income Energy Assistance Program)

Pays part of winter energy bills for eligible people. If eligible, the payment amount is figured according to the size and type of your home and type of fuel used. The Weatherization Program helps improve the heating efficiency of homes and permanently reduces energy consumption. Eligibility is based on income. Owners and renters alike may apply for these programs. If your household is receiving benefits from SSI or AFDC, you may qualify automatically for these programs. You may apply for LIEAP October 1 through April 30.
